

SAM Challenge - BELONGING - St Silas Academy

Phase 1 Years 1-3

Home

Play a game with your family. It can be a game you have made up or a game that you often play. Take a photograph or make a drawing showing the game you played. Explain how to play it.

Help your parents to make a meal for your family. Make sure you have adult supervision when you are chopping up the raw ingredients. Draw, photograph or make a model of the meal.

Draw a picture of your face. What expression have you used - sad, happy, upset? Around the picture name feelings you have had, both good and not so good. Explain what makes you feel good and what makes you feel not so good. Show how our faces and bodies show these feelings to others.

Wider Community

Find out about two festivals or celebrations from your own faith or another. Make a poster or collage, take photographs, write a story or a poem about one of them.

What is a community? Who works in your community? Is there anyone who volunteers? What do they do? Write down some questions to find out why they volunteer. What do they get in return? What difference do they make?

Visit a virtual museum or art gallery online, such as Blackburn Museum and Art Gallery, Helmshore Textile Museum, Queen Street Mill Textile Museum in Burnley, Haworth Art Gallery Accrington or Ribchester Roman Museum. Design a leaflet to publicise the museum or art gallery.

Draw a picture of a community service worker showing what they do. For eg, School Crossing Patrol (Lollipop man/lady), Police Officer/PCSO, Fire Fighter, nurse, Postal Worker, teacher. Label your picture. Describe how they have helped you or your family.
